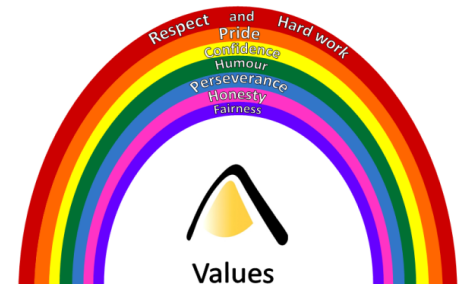


Home – School Agreement
